
India's Cup 2020 Event Overview

Distance:

2,700 kilometers (1,677 miles)

Once assembled, they embark on a 2700 KM trek across India in their vehicles of choice, be it a classic Ambassador or their brand new Mahindra, finally reaching Panaji, Goa after 13 eventful days.
